Specific rules of Research Performing Organisation Météo-France

The official call announcement has been published on the CNRM Intranet site and in the CNRM newsletter. Details of the call and the application process are provided via the ERA4CS website. Applicants are advised to contact the Contact Point mentioned below before starting to prepare proposals for application.

The maximum support for Météo-France research teams for this call is 1 587 548,7 Euros.

This may include all types of costs considered eligible under H2020 (salaries, travel, computing resources, etc...).

Eligibility and funding modalities:

There are no specific requirements for Météo-France scientists to participate in proposals submitted to the call, but all intentions must have been declared in due time to the contact person mentioned below and validated by the Director of Research.

The three subtopics of Topic B are eligible for Météo-France funding.

There is no specific limit to the funding that Météo-France can bring to any single proposal, however the total funding will remain within the limit mentioned above.

It is expected that applications to this call will be Collaborative Research Grants with the consortium composition as defined in the call document.

Funding plan should be drafted in accordance with H2020 financial rules.
