Specific rules for Research Performing Organisation: MET OFFICE, for and on behalf of the SECRETARY OF STATE FOR BUSINESS, INNOVATION AND SKILLS OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND (Met Office)

The official call announcement has been published on the ERA4CS website, and has been communicated to the relevant science teams within the Met Office. Details of the call and the application process are provided via the ERA4CS website. Applicants are requested to contact their Contact Point mentioned below before starting to prepare proposals for application.

The maximum support for Met Office participants is the equivalent in pounds sterling of 330K Euros (according to exchange rates at time of funding).

Eligibility and funding modalities: All applicants must be members of staff within Met Office science programmes. All intentions to participate in proposals submitted to the call must have been declared in due time to the contact person mentioned below and approved by the Director of Climate Science.

Proposals of sub-topic(s):

- B.1: Development of new methods and tools
- B.2: Impacts studies and models
- B.3: Localization of Climate Information and Uncertainties Evaluation

are eligible for Met Office funding. There is no specific limit to the funding that the Met Office can bring to any single proposal, except the total funding will remain within the limit mentioned above of 330K Euros.

It is expected that applications to this call will be Collaborative Research Grants with the consortium composition as defined in the call document.

Funding plan should be drafted in accordance with H2020 financial rules.
