Eligibility and funding modalities: 1. Proposals are eligible if aligned with the eligible sub-topics of NCSR Demokritos and fall within the highlighted domains of interest described below; 2. Applicants should prove capacity to cover the associated in-kind costs of the organization's participation in funded projects.

Proposals of sub-topic(s):

B.1: Development of new methods and tools

B.2: Impacts studies and models

B.3: Localization of Climate Information and Uncertainties Evaluation

are eligible for National Center for Scientific Research Demokritos funding. National Center for Scientific Research Demokritos will fund up to 400 k€, per proposal total budget.

National Center for Scientific Research Demokritos has particular interest in the development of climate services based upon high resolution climate simulations (in the time scales from monthly to multi-decadal), which will be used to determine localised impacts on economic sectors of interest (transport, energy, agriculture, tourism,...). The outcome of the research should be translated into useful information for the potential user community

It is expected that applications to this call will be Collaborative Research Grants with the consortium composition as defined in the call document, and National Center for Scientific Research Demokritos's in kind contribution will fund researchers of any successful transnational collaboration, according to the general rules stated in the call.

Funding plan should be drafted in accordance with H2020 ERANET CoFund financial rules.
